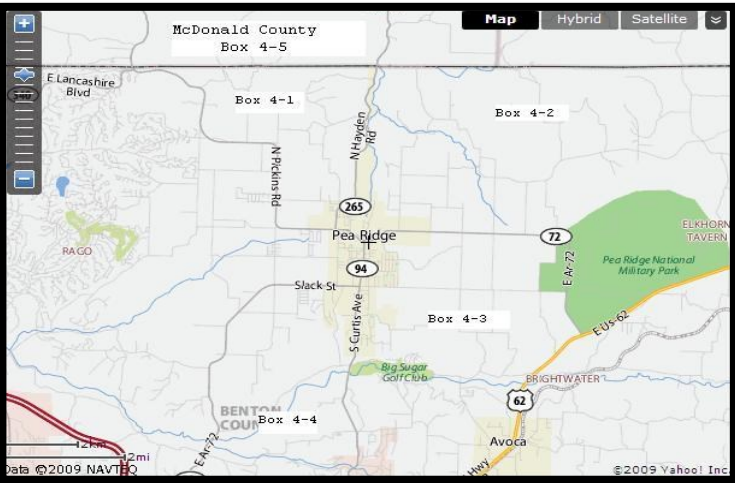
Driver Operator—City Mapping

Equipment, Props, Information or Other Resources Needed: A street map of the city of Pea Ridge.

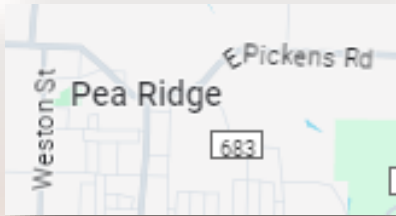
INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS CORE COMPETENCY DRILL

When listening to a dispatch the location is usually given by box and then address. By recognizing the location of the box given you should be able to determine what area of the city you will be responding.

Identify these roads along with any businesses or high hazard facilities that correspond with these roads.

- 4-1 – Northwest – North of Slack Street and west of N Curtis—Mutual Aid—Bella Vista EMS
- 4-2 – Northeast – North of Lee Town Drive and east of N Curtis—Mutual Aid—NEBCO EMS
- 4-3 – Southeast – South of Lee Town Drive and east of S Curtis—Mutual Aid—NEBCO EMS
- 4-4 – Southwest – South of Slack Street and west of S Curtis—Mutual Aid—Bentonville EMS
