Hazardous Materials —Absorbent Materials

DESCRIPTION AND EXPECTED PERFORMANCE: Each member shall study, review, and discuss in a group exercise, using haz-mat inventory, any and all absorbent materials available for crews to utilize during Haz-Mat incidents. What procedures can combine with Absorbent actions if taken should be discussed, and what actions necessary to dispose of soiled materials.

Use a simulated chemical spill, incorporated the

ERG, and then pick an absorbent material and practice a small exercise. You may simulate absorbent pads with old towels to save cost.

Have each member lead a different scenario. Incorporate a small damming and diking exercise if the C/O would like.
