Driver Operator—Specialty Nozzle Pumping

DESCRIPTION AND EXPECTED PERFORMANCE: This Driver Operator Drill can be done in conjunction with other drills and should be logged separately. The purpose is to rotate Driver/Operators, and future Driver/Operators for continued training on how to provide the appropriate PDP to hose lines with specialty nozzles.

Length: 2 HOURS

REFERENCE: NFPA 1002 Standards. Fire-fighting Essentials, 6th ed. IFSTA. PRFD SOPs and Guidelines related to Driver Operator and Pump Operations.

Equipment, Props, Information or Other Resources Needed: Apparatus, hose lines, and specialty nozzles with a large enough area to safely conduct drills with appropriate PPE donned.
