## CORE COMPETENCY DRILL



### Hazardous Material—Decontamination

**DESCRIPTION AND EXPECTED PERFORMANCE:** To perform a setup of formal decontamination equipment and run through of procedures. Each member should be able to help perform ground support operations of the Haz-Mat Team during incidents. The Formal Decon. Setup is usually between the Red Zone and Warm Zone; and then moving cleaned victims to the green.

**Length: 2 HOURS**

**REFERENCE:** PRFD S.O.G.s for Decontamination of members after at declared Hazardous Materials Incident. Review NFPA standards 1001, 1002, 1584 and OSHA guidelines.

**Equipment, Props, Information or Other Resources Needed:** You will need full PPE, Haz-Mat trailer, and all of the formal decon. Equipment. Also, you will need a Haz-Mat Team member present to go through the setup with you. Please handle all equipment with care and report any damage equipment immediately.
