## **CORE COMPETENCY DRILL**



Ladders — Vent, Enter, Isolate, and Search (V.E.I.S.)

**DESCRIPTION AND EXPECTED PERFORMANCE:** Practice the techniques of vent, enter, isolate, and search when other means of entry are not feasible.

**Equipment, Props, Information or Other Resources Needed:** Select an elevated area, such as an area at Station 4 in the bay upper level storage area. Pad areas and the floor where scratches could occur. Ground ladder, axe, Haligan, and full protective gear with SCBA. A T.I.C., flashlight, and a hose line.

Length: 2 HOURS

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS CORE COMPETENCY DRILL







Each member takes the lead. Someone butts the ladder, two up the ladder, one sounds the floor inside with a tool and a quick victim check, move into the structure, 2nd FF moves to the window with the T.I.C. to get the layout and monitor for safety while in contact. FF 1 isolates the room from the rest of the structure by closing the door, then completes the search. If you come to a victim, make radio contact and then facilitate rescue. Practice good but quick technique and comm.'s.
