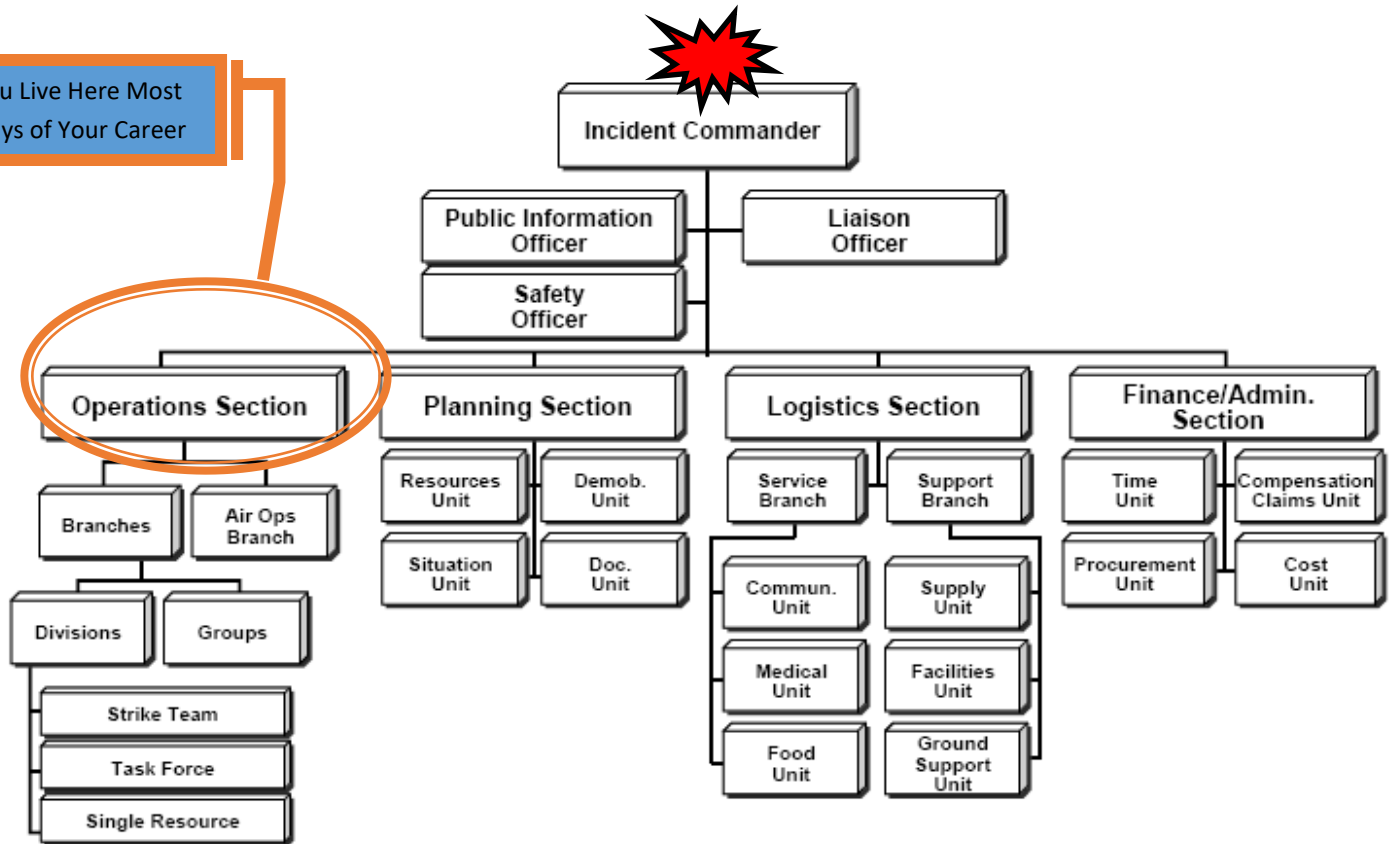
Length: 2 HOURS
